THEORETICAL TRAINING

Services SETA accredited SDPs that were still doing theoretical training and have an online or digital platforms to continue training must apply to the Services SETA using a form for [Online Learning Application Form](#).

EXTERNAL MODERATION

SDPs that have completed their assessment and have LA numbers can now apply to the Services SETA to conduct External Moderation online. The [External Moderation Form](#) is available on the website.

WORKPLACE TRAINING

Learners must return to the workplaces and training institutions in line with their gradual opening as per guidelines of each Level. At Level 4 only certain industries and essential services companies are allowed back at work. Learners whose workplaces are not required back, must align with the processes of their workplaces. .

MANDATORY GRANTS SUBMISSIONS

Submission of Work Skills Plans and Annual Training Plans has been extended to 31 May 2020. The Minister of Higher Education, Science and Technology issued [Gazette no 43278](#) to extend the date for the submission of Mandatory Grants applications for 2020/21 Financial Year.
